Examination Attendance

All matriculated students are expected to attend all assigned academic activities for each course currently registered. Medical excuses will be based on self-reporting by students to the Dean of Students Office via the online SAS Medical Excuse link.

Students who feel they are too sick to take an examination or other required activity on a specific day must submit the <u>online SAS medical excuse</u>, which is available on the SGU Portal. Students are only allowed a total of two such excuses in two consecutive semesters. If a third excuse is submitted within two consecutive semesters, the Office of the Dean of Students will consult with the Director of University Health Service and a medical leave of absence may be mandated.

Students who miss an examination with a submitted excuse and wish to petition for a completion exam should contact their Course Instructor.
