## Appendix U: Illinois Clinical Placement Exception

Effective May 2022, students will be able to be placed into Illinois 3<sup>rd</sup> year clerkships if:

- 1. passed all curricular requirements and
- 2. are nearing or at timeline requirements and
- 3. have failed their USMLE step 1 exam

or

- 1. passed all curricular requirements and
- 2. are nearing or at timeline requirements and
- 3. cannot obtain a valid VISA to travel to the UK (documentation required)

This would be an exception to the current policy which requires students to have successfully passed USMLE Step 1 to commence clerkships in the United States. Students will be required to complete all pre-placement requirements prior to be confirmed for placement.

Students would be able to only complete required rotations (Internal Medicine, Surgery, OB/GYN, Pediatrics, Psychiatry and Family Medicine). They would not be allowed to continue into their  $4^{th}$  year until they have passed USMLE Step 1 and have met progression requirements to  $4^{th}$  year.
